

**WebVoyage Committee Meeting
August 11, 2005
Kapi'olani Community College**

MINUTES

1. Approve minutes from 7/14/05.

We couldn't remember the details from some of the previous meeting agenda items.

Action: Steph to add some background information, also to send any missing minutes to Susan for posting on WebVoyage page.

2. Update: Voyager patch (Kellett).

The patch should fix the Location display on Print/Save screens (Systems tested and this works.) New clients are already available; Jerard tested them with the current server and they seem to work. Patch work planned for Friday 8/19 (Admissions Day) and sites have been asked to email assist@hawaii.edu if they will be open.

3. Update: uhlibs Virtual Host.

Carol has implemented the non-library specific virtual host at uhlibs.lib.hawaii.edu. It looks great! We had previously mentioned needing to reword the "Your Account" Login page, but it looked okay.

Decision: Leave Login page as is unless any problems are reported.

4. Update: Firefox plugin.

Tabled until 9-month faculty return and have a chance to try it and give input.

5. Update: Usage Statistics (Susan, Carol)

Unfortunately, the NJIT implementation of these Circulation statistics uses a Cold Fusion script. Systems doesn't use Cold Fusion because of security issues. This means we can't just copy what NJIT did. It might be possible with a PHP/Perl script, but it would be a new programming project for the Systems office.

Decision: Table until there is more interest, and the load on Systems is lighter.

6. Update: More Like This.

Tabled until 9-month faculty return and have a chance to try it and give input.

7. Update: Videorecording Limiters.

On uhshared, the Search Limits page has an additional limit under Format: "Serial Videorecording/DVD" which looks for "gs" coding in the 008. This is very useful for finding items like the Merrie Monarch festival. The "Videorecording/DVD" Format limit looks for "gm" coding in the 008, and unfortunately they can't be combined on the Search Limits page. The Quick Limit for "Videorecording/DVD" on the Basic Search page *does* combine the gs and gm limits, and the Quick Limit overrides any limits set on the Search Limits page.

It might be possible for Cataloging staff to pull and edit all videorecording records so that their 007 fields are correct. Then the Quick Limit could revert to looking in the 007, and the Search Limits page could have "Videorecording/DVD" under the Medium limit rather than the Format limit. (Note: Medium is currently only on uhshared, but when final wording for Electronic Text is determined, Medium can be added to public hosts.) However, we might want to retain the "Serial Videorecording/DVD" option under Format for staff use, but move it to the bottom of the list.

Action: Mike to check on the feasibility of editing all 007s. Carol will update Manoa's virtual host to include "Serial Videorecording/DVD" on the Search Limits page--other sites can request this if they would like it as well.

8. Electronic Text Quick Limit (Chopey).

There is currently a limit under Format on the Search Limits page called "Electronic Resources". It mostly finds programs and CD-ROMs, but does *not* find what most people are looking for, i.e. online content. Manoa has requested a new Quick Limit that looks for computer file coding in the 007, and to have the Search Limits page changed to have the same 007 "computer file" limiter under Medium (instead of the current limit under Format). This new limit *will* find online resources. However, it still pulls programs and CD-ROMs--it is not possible to limit to online resources only.

We need input from public services staff as to what the label for the new Limit should be. It is currently implemented on uhshared with the label "Electronic Text".

Action: When 9-month faculty have returned, have them test and give suggestions for limit label.

9. Update: UHVCC Meeting.

Highlights from the 8/10/05 UHVCC Meeting:

- Awaiting recommendation from all functional committees for December upgrade to Voyager version 5.
- Manoa's Travel Industry Management (TIM) Library has been added to Voyager.
 - virtual host is live: uhtim.lib.hawaii.edu
 - location will be added to Search Limits page as UH Sch TIM.
 - only about 10,000 holdings; many bibs already in Voyager.
 - will affect some sites that use Bin Zhang's collection-specific link.
- MeSH: staff-side 6502 index cannot be simply added to the OPAC. It might be possible to buy it for \$1500, it might not. SCCC will discuss in the fall, WebVoyage should help keep public services and LILC in the loop.
- Library Council has asked that all functional committees begin evaluating Voyager.

Action: Begin listing Likes, Dislikes, and What's Missing for the OPAC, to be discussed in the Fall and reported to UHVCC by the end of the year.
