To His Excellency WILLIAM McKINLEY, President,

Island of Moloscan, who are members  
of the HAWAIIAN PATRIOTIC LEAGUE OF THE HAWAII-  
AN ISLANDS, and others who are in sympathy with the  
said League, earnestly protest against the annexation of  
the said Hawaiian Islands to the said United States of  
America in any form or shape.
